Legislative Provisions

Motorcycle (1-time) registration - \$16.00; special motorcycle license plate - \$5.00; motorcycle license endorsement - 63.46% of \$4.00 (8-yr. Renewal)

Only to support motorcycle safety training courses, Instructor training and related training activities. Course facility construction, repair or purchase may be funded.

Board of Regents to: establish course standards; approve courses; distribute funds; periodically monitor courses; establish Instructor standards based on the MSF's or similar organization; approve Instructors; promote public and private courses; and authorize unit of University system to conduct courses. 5-member advisory committee created.
